
## A fine art student who once dreamed of becoming an artist






I started out as a student journalist in college.

I have made a living as an after-school art instructor at an elementary school.






The innocent world of children attracted me more and more.





### The Answer is: "Fun" activities






## Children's questions quenched my thirst for creativity

## The perfect dictation score from my 1st grade daughter



## Resource recycling moved from the public domain to individuals' daily routines.












#### When you add your imagination to materials,

born fresh with new imagination






Discarded materials and waste

A buoy has become a lampshade.








The very gift that I want to give to my newborn baby
